

International Special Advisors of NDF (Nuclear Damage Compensation and Decommissioning Facilitation Corporation) visited the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station

The International Special Advisors of the decommissioning strategy committee for the Nuclear Damage Compensation and Decommissioning Facilitation Corporation (NDF) of Japan visited the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station to see the progress of the decommissioning on March 9, 2023. They were given a close look at decommissioning work from high ground overlooking the Units 1-4. They were also shown the ALPS related facilities such as the additionally installed ALPS, and the dilution/discharge facility. Furthermore, they visited the chemical analysis building to inspect the analysis of Tritium.

We also explained that TEPCO has been widely disseminating information on our efforts to discharge ALPS treated water into the sea through newspaper advertisements and other ways, in addition to individual responses such as explanatory meetings, etc. We received the following comment: "We have felt that TEPCO has been providing accurate information in a highly transparent manner."

TEPCO continues to disseminate information based on scientific evidence to parties within and outside Japan after securing high transparency and move safely and steadily forward with the long-term decommissioning process.
